The following is a copy of my notes for a Boone Co. Ill. Genealogy lecture, given March 9, 1985 to members of the North Central Ill. Genealogical Society, at the Rockford Public Library Auditorium. They meet every 2nd saturday of the month here.

1. Hello I'm Martin Wm. Johnson. I'm 36 yrs. old & have been tracing ancestors for 16 yrs.. I'm mainly interested in Northern Ill. history & Genealogy sources, along with tracing the old German Lutherans in East central Wisconsin, East central Minnesota & West central New York from 1839 to present.
2. I've been asked to speak on Boone county Genealogy sources. This will take approximately 45 minutes.
3. The Belvidere Cemetery office has a card index of burials & burial entry books. Out of town deaths or transfers usually give the place the person died.
4. Hellen Williams (Mrs. Jay Williams of Belvidere) will have indexed & typed up the 1860 Boone Co. census, sometime this month.
5. Gwen Anderson of Belvidere is compiling a book on the Garden Prairie cemetery. It will include grave inscriptions, newspaper obituaries, genealogical information about the families etc.. If you have any information contact her.
6. The Boone Co. court house gives researcher's xerox copies of birth, death & marriage indexes to look at. These indexes are very faded. Some letters are continued in back of a index. Most don't go to 1916. For example the ^{2nd} marriage index marked 1858 to 1883 includes some overlapping 1857 marriages from the earlier index and only goes up to 1878. There are two indexes in this book. One goes from 1857 to 1878 and a index in back of the book goes to 1883, but is not xeroxed for our use. Entries in the book go to 1898. the third book goes from 1877 on. Each of these books overlap each other, but are not marked as such. The death index says 1877 to 1915, but does not cover the years 1910 to 1915 fully. Some are in one book and some are in the next book, for 1910 to 1915. Other indexes have similar overlapping years, but are not marked as such on indexes or books.
7. The marriage certificates in Ill. from 1877 on have a health form attached to the back. It asks the place of birth of the bride & groom, and the full names of their parents. In Boone Co. this seems to start at about certificate No. 1816. Be sure to check these latter marriage certificates for a ancestors 1st., 2nd or 3rd marriage and his brothers or sisters marriage certificates. There are early marriage information in Historical Encyclopedia of Ill. & History of Boone Co. Volume II, 1909, pages 762-780.
8. Deaths in Ill. started being recorded in 1877. Up to 1916 they usually give name, age, state or country born & date & place they died. The probate records in Boone Co. start fairly early and usually list where & when the person died & list his relatives and latter on their addresses. There is a book index of one volume for almost all years.
9. The naturalization records are indexed in two metal file boxes. One of the indexes starts over alphabetically in the back of each letter, with grey cards for latter years. After 1906 a person applying for or receiving citizenship, had to fill out a long application giving his name, date & place of birth in detail, town he lived in before coming to the U.S., port & name of ship he left on & port, date & name of ship he arrived on, and information about his wife and children. Some people waited until World War One etc. to apply for citizenship. Some Canadian's applied for citizenship in early years.
10. A lot of the early Grantee land records, give the name of the county back east a person was from or living when he purchased land in Boone Co.. There are two early land record books. One is volume A and the other volume AA, which has the purchases by people living in the disputed one mile strip of land, on the west edge of Boone Co.. It was latter declared part of Boone Co., by the Ill. state Legislature in 1843. The Winnebago Co. court house had to send duplicate copies of land transactions up to this time to the Boone Co. court house in 1843. I suspect many marriages etc. for people living in this one mile strip were recorded at the Winnebago Co. court house, and never recorded at the Boone Co. court house..
11. The Boone Co. indexes and records in the early years are full of spelling errors & in some cases the way a name may show up back east. When a English clerk or census taker wrote down a name as it was pronounced to him, by a german, french, swedish etc. immigrant or a by a person who did not read or write, it was recorded the way it sounded. The first letter in a surname was recorded as C instead of K etc.. Vowels were added or dropped. Letters were doubled or dropped. Letters such as Mc, O, De, Van, Le etc. were added or dropped from surnames. The most common errors are Y instead of i, ee instead of ei, script like w's for r's, Faded W's look like M's, faded T's, J's & F's looking alike, in Capital letters. Use your imagination. copy down entries that are similar and exchange with others tracing the same surname you are. Even if you knew they are not your ancestors. My own last name started out in Harne, Holstein, Germany area as Johannssen and was changed to Jansen & Johnson after they got to the Lake/Cook County line area, in 1853. Use your imagination.
12. When looking for obituaries, check the Rockford, Harvard and Marengo papers from 1880's on, if a Belvidere paper turns up no obituary.
13. The Ida Public Library in Belvidere is open M-F 11 - 9 & Sat. 10 - 6 . The librarians' office has most of the history & Genealogy books etc.. The library personell have to get the books out for you. They have a typed list of information available. The head librarian is Jean Newcomer. She has done a great job of organizing & adding to their collection of history & genealogy sources.
14. The following books & items are mentioned in the March/April 1985 NCIGS newsletter. I will name & no. each book as in the newsletter and add the important information to be found in each item. Anyone taking notes can note the No. and any additions I make. Books # 1-5 are a 1896 Belvidere Illustrated book, by Belvidere Daily Republican paper. It has a history of Schools & Churches etc.. on pages 6-28. Biographies with portraits, residence pictures etc. are on pages 62 - 171. Books # 6-9 are the Past & Present of Boone Co. 1877. Page 226 starts a history of Boone

- County.. Civil War veterans are listed alphabetically for each regiment, with dates of enlistment & discharges etc.. Officers are listed at beginning of Regiment. This inf. is on pages 254 - 266. Pages 276 - 319 have township histories with information about schools, churches, cemeteries, & newspapers. Pages 325 - 336 give personal recollections by early settlers. Pages 336 - 338 have information about the oldest Boone Co. People. Pages 341 - 414 is a list of residents of Boone Co., by township in alphabetical order. Some of these paid to have included a short one or two inch biography of their immediate family. A few pictures of some are through out the book. This 1877 book is still being reprinted by - The Book Mart, P.O. Box 74, Knightstown, Ind. 46148. Tel. No. 317-345-5335.
- Books # 27 - 32 are Historical Encyclopedia of Ill. & the history of Boone Co, 1909 by Richard V. Carpenter. A two volume book. Volume one, & half of volume two have a history of Illinois and a index to statewide Ill. biographies only. It dose not index the Boone Co. Biographies in Alphabetical order on pages 823 - 942. The Boone Co. section in volume two starts on page 661. Pages 661 - 692 give early Boone Co. history & stories by early settlers, of early movements, deaths, & arrivals in Boone Co.. Pages 692 - 708 give township histories. Pages 728 -729 gives inf. on papers. Pages 730 - 736 gives church histories. Pages 738 - 758 gives War rosters through the Spanish American War. Pages 759 - 762 gives information on prominent & early citizens. Pages 762 - 781 gives dates of arrival of people and who they married back east or in Boone Co.. Husbands are listed alphabetically by township. Pages 790 - 822 lists events taken from the Belvidere paper, in chronological order from 1865 to 1894. Then 10 years of events on one page, which includes death notices. A few pictures are also in this last half of volume two.
- Books # 33 - 34 are the 1892 Portrait & Biographical record of Winnebago & Boone Co. Ill.. It has a Picture and Biography index. (also see # 161 for all name index).
- Books # 36 - 40 are a History of the Rock River Valley 1926. Many Biographies in this three volume book.
- Book # 41 is a book called Hunter by Maude E. Ward. It is Biographies for families in Manchester twp. in N/W Boone Co. In front is a list of surnames in alphabetical order for biographies for this area of Hunter and surrounding area. Not all surnames are listed in index. Only main surname headings. There are a few errors in some of these biographies, so double check information, in this book and any other books.
- Book # 42 Boone Co. Centennial Celebration book - 1838 to 1938. It has historical events of Boone Co..
- Book # 46 is Called Flora (a township) a history of south prairie, fairfield, Benton & Flora by Herbert Hallstrom.
- Book # 48 is cemetery inscriptions by Hazel Hyde & Taylor Decker. It includes Blood's point, Flora & Livingston cemetery. The day & month of death & birth will be on stone.
- Book # 49 is a history of the Co. line cemetery at Capron, Ill., by Minerva Blackburn-1975.
- Book # 50 is a Census index of Illinois 1840 for Ill. counties Adams through Dupage, by Maxine Wornier.
- Book # 51 - 52 is a mortality schedule for Ill. 1850 Adams through Iroquois Co's. and 1860 Adams through Effingham co's., by Lowell Volkell.
- Book # 54 is a Boone Co. directory by Hansen's 1937.
- Book # 55 is a red covered plat book of the state of Ill., about 1952. It shows all Illinois counties, townships, back roads, and rural schools and a swastika marks all rural cemeteries.
- Book # 60 - 61 is a book on General Stephen A. Hurlbut by Juliet Gilman Sager.
- Book # 64 is a book on the Argyle settlement in history & story by Daniel G. Harvey 1924. The argyle settlement was in Winnebago Co. untill 1843, when half of it in the contested mile strip became part of Boone Co.. Church is in Winnebago Co. & Cemetery is in Boone Co..
- Book # 69 is the Life of Henry Ruitter by Rick Ashton (Woods family in it).
- Book # 71 is a Genealogy of the Odiorne family in America by David W. Odiorne.
- Book # 74 is a book on Joseph Schwedersky & his family by Stephen & Ione Schwedersky.
- Book # 75 is Mills Belvidere city directory, Including Boone Co. 1896/97. They also have Belvidere directories for years 1910 to present, on the shelf behind desk.
- Book # 78 is Boone Co. marriages 1838 to 1860 by Robert L. Steenrod. It is indexed and all information from the actual records are in the book. There is a card file of marriages before this date at the Boone Co. court house in the back room upstairs. These should be indexed.
- Book # 79 is for Davis cemetery on western Boone Co. line on Rt. 20. It diagrams the cemetery and marks certain names on some of them.. (See book # 146-148).
- Book # 80 -81 is Cherry Valley - Our memories are warm, 1835 - 1976.
- Book # 82 is a book on the Whitting & Warren families in Boone Co., Ill. by Clara M. Turner of Beaver Dam, Wisc.. 1983, Lot of other families mentioned.
- Book # 83 is a book on Charles A. Fox, of untitled remainiscenses.
- Book # 85 is History of Green Co. Wisc. 1884.
- Book # 96 is Bibliography of Co. histories in 50 states. It tells what co. history books & atlases etc. were printed over the years for 50 states. Be sure to check for books on a parent county or counties that were formed from a parent co. for history books.
- Book # 89 is the 1905 Past & Present of the city of Rockford, Ill.. Many family Biographies.
- Book # 99 is Illustrated Roster of the Dept. of Ill. Grand Army of the Republic 1914 by William C. Shaw.
- Book # 108 is a March 1982 free issue of the book, newspapers in the State Historical library in, the issue of Illinois libraries. All papers can be interlibrary loaned on microfilm.
- Book # 109 is a folder of items on the Presbyterian church of Belvidere.
- Book # 110 is a book on the Belvidere High School . Belvidera High School year books from 1914 through 1984 are behind the librarians desk. Youwill find early pictures of ancestors in these school books.

Book # 112 is Mayflower descendants & their marriages after landing, by Bureau of Military and Civic achievement, 1922 Washington, D.C..

Book # 119 Records of Boone Co. Ill. by Mrs. Harlin Taylor. Lists early citizens of 1837 and has a record of the older people in 1877. Surname index in back.

Book # 120 is for the Capron Centennial 1873 to 1973.

Book # 122 is Honor Roll for Boone Co. Ill. by Ill. Veterans Commission 1956. Lists veterans buried in Boone Co. by cemetery, in alphabetical order, Also war they were in, rank or duties, date of death. All wars.

Items # 134 - 140 are seven rolls of microfilm copies of the 1840 through 1910 Boone Co. census. Plus a few other counties on the rolls. The 1900 & 1910 Boone Co. census gives all names, relationship to head of household, race, sex, month & year born, age, No. yrs. married, No. of children the mother had, No. of children living, State or country their parents were born in, even if not on the census, like the 1880 census. Gives occupations, year of immigration to the U.S. & if a naturalized citizen or a Alien. 1910 also gives nationality of a person, such as Scotch/Irish or German/American etc.. Also the names of roads or streets are on left margin.

Book # 141 is a History of Mc Henry Co. Ill 1885. Many short biographies.

Book # 143 is about Sidney Edward Chase and Elizabeth B. Miller Chase & Descendants.

Books # 146 - 148 are cemetery inscriptions for the townships of Belvidere, Caledonia, Popular Grove, Bonus, LeRoy, Manchester & Shattucks grove cem. in Spring Twp.. If you don't find a grave your looking for in these books, it doesn't mean they are not buried there. Cemeteries such as the Catholic cemetery in Belvidere are missing many stones and many graves never have had a stone put on them.. When going through old Boone Co. records, remember that Spring twp. was formerly called (Ohio & Concord Twp.). Flora Twp. was formerly called (Fairfield & Benton Twp.). Even Cherry Valley Twp. was formerly called Butler Twp.. Many Northern Ill. townships changed names from 1840 to 1850.

Book # 153 is Caledonia, a History, Reminiscence & Commentary by Carl T. Ralston.

Book # 154 is Hellen Williams (Mrs. Jay Williams of Belvidere) book on the Maxwells of Vernon Co. Wisc. and related families.

Book # 155 is the Collins-Cadwell Genealogy by Margaret U. Lofquist of Arlington Heights, Ill. 1983.

Book # 157 is on the Russellville cemetery. It is a index & cemetery inscriptions.

Book # 159 is the Belvidere cemetery records transcribed for years 1836 through 1900 by Hellen Williams 1984. She is also presently working on the pre 1840 Boone Co. settlers project. If we all worked one twentieth as much as Hellen has, all the records for Winnebago & Boone Co. would be in Book form by now. She's doing a great job, & service for her fellow genealogists.

Book # 161 is a all name index to the 1892 Portrait & Biographical record of Winnebago & Boone Co. Ill.. Compiled by Ernest Jackson. He is doing a great job of getting these indexes compiled and published.

Book # 162 is the 1850 Boone Co. Census in Book form, by Harley Haskin of Lebanon, Oregon. Books that are to be added to their collection in a week or so, are a alphabetical computer print out of the early land track purchase records for Boone Co. Ill., from the Ill. State Archives. Each county in Ill. can get a copy of their own counties land records. But only one free copy will be sent to one library in each county. The other book is a index to the county records of Ill., that are on microfilm or in book form in each of the Ill. regional archives depository systems, 1984. Northern Ill. University is the depository for the Northern Ill. county, church, town etc. records anyone wants to have permanently stored. Most of Ogle & Carroll Co's. court house records are on microfilm in Dekalb now.

Anyone wanting to donate books or family histories etc. should send them to Jean Newcomer % Local history & Genealogy file, Ida Public Library, Belvidere, Ill. 61008. They have two shelves of History & tracing ancestors books, starting in section 929, which are not in the librarians office. Donated books should be marked if they can be checked out or not. They subscribe to Genealogy Today & Everton's Genealogical Helper magazine. In the basement is the microfilm reader. In the adjoining room are microfilm copies of the Belvidere paper from 1900 on. They also have bound copies of the paper in this room for newspapers from April 1917 to Dec. 1975.

15. The Basement vault at the Ida Public library has 33 bound volumes of the Belvidere newspaper for years 1851 through 1899. Other volumes are as follows-

Volume # 34 is the Belvidere Recorder, a semi weekly paper for Yrs. 1878 through 1879. This is a different paper than the previously mentioned Belvidere Standard paper.

Volume # 35 & 36 is the Chicago Daily Tribune for yrs. 1876.

Volume # 37 is the Daily Illinois State Journal of Springfield, Ill. for Jan. - March 1865 & Jan. - Feb. 1867 & Jan. - April 1869.

Volume # 38 is a 1905 Boone Co. atlas, which has a patrons list, with information about themselves.

Volume # 38½ is a 1886 atlas of Boone Co., which has pictures of citizens & their homes & or farms.

Volume # 39 is a 1923 atlas of Boone Co., which has pictures of citizens & their homes.

Volume # 40 is a 1871 Atlas of Winnebago Co. & the state of Ill..

Volume # 42 is Harper's pictorial history of the Great Rebellion, 1868.

Volume # 43 is the Stars & strips paper from Feb. 8, 1918 to June 13, 1919.

Book # 51 is the Prairie farmers reliable directory of farmers & breeders in Mc Henry & Boone Co., Ill. 1917. Both sections of the book are in alphabetical order & give date born or settled in the county.

Book # 55½ is a Catalogue of the Public library of Ill. 1877.

Book # 56 is Notes on the life of General Stephen A. Hurlbut.

Book # 59 is the North Belvidere High School year book 1900.

Book # 60 is the Washington School year books for 1935 & 1939.

Item # 68 is a unidentified group photo at the Presbyterian church.

Book # 88 is the History of the 59th regiment, Ill. volunteers, 1865.

Book # 89 is a history of the 95th regiment, Ill. volunteers, 1865.

Book # 108 is a History of Ill. from its commencement as a state in 1814 to 1847, by Former Gov. Thomas Ford, 1854.

Book # 120 is Newspapers & Periodicals of Ill. 1814 to 1879, by Franklin William Scott.

Book # 127 is Ill. Historical Collections book & is titled the County Archives of Ill. by Theodore Calvin Pease, 1915. It gives all records in Illinois court houses as of 1915. Each county is listed separately, with dates & types of information in the records. This is a very good book.

Item # 148 Presbyterian communicants of April 1853. 1947.

Book # 146 The Old farmers almanac 1865.

Book # 149 Journal of the Ill. Historical Soc. July 1937. Has Ill. place names. Oct. 1936 information about the 130th National Guard infantry.

Book # 151 History of the 33rd Division Volume 4, World War One, by Ill. State Hist. Soc..

I have recently completed a transcription of 1,946 Boone Co. marriages, from the Boone Co. Ill. court house indexes, for the period of Sept. 2, 1857 to March 26, 1878. Also a index of 2,492 deaths for approximate years of 1877 to 1909. There are a few for years 1910 - 1915 that should have been recorded in the 2nd death record book, 1910 - 1915. Hellen Williams typed up the marriages I transcribed. She went through various local history books and corrected spelling errors in the index of marriages. I typed the death index and did not change any misspellings, even if I knew they were misspelled. Use these indexes as a guide and not the gospel. I do make mistakes. These two indexes and a copy of todays lecture are \$15.00 .

Are there any people present who are not members of the North Central Ill. Gen. Soc. and would like to join ? It's \$5.00 a year. It's newsletter has good information and the card lets you check the Ill. court house birth, death & marriage indexes up to 1916 free of charge. Ask a member here today or the librarian in the Genealogy room on the third floor.

Abraham, Caroline born March 20, 1820 in Neu Stettin Co., W. Prussia-to Chicago 1875. died March 9, 1891 Riley Twp. Mc Henry Co., Ill.. Husband Carl/Karl Gus(s)e. From The village of Woosterberg, Wosterberg, Wusterburg, Worstabad in HinterPommern state.

Armstrong, Mary Jane born April 7, 1855-58 Cobleskill, Schoharie Co. N.Y., Died Jan. 6, 1947 Belvidere, Ill., Married Feb. 12, 1874 in Rockford to Wm. Wilbur Walter Wicks. Her parents were John Armstrong and Sarah (A.) Willoughby. To Ill. 1876.

Aubrey, Grace Elsie born May 17, 1880 Barrington or Dundee, Ill., Died Jan. 1, 1974 Belvidere. Married Elwood Grimes Nov. 17, 1898 in Union or MARENGO, Ill., Her parents were William Robert Aubrey born Dec. 21, 1852 in Had(d)enham, Cambridgeshire, England. To Barrington, Ill. 1870. Returned to Hadenham & married Sarah Annie Watts June 17, 1877 & returned to Dundee, Ill.. bought a house one mile east of Marengo in 1903. He died Nov. 12, 1907 in Marengo. She died Sept. 24, 1921 in Belvidere.

Behnke, Rose(a) Mildred Bertha Emilie born Nov. 13, 1886-7 Riley or Seneca Twp., Mc Henry Co., Ill.. Died Aug. 5, 1966 Belvidere. Married Nov. 11, 1907 in Union, Ill., to Walter Albert G. Yerk. Her father was Edward Behnke born Jan. or Feb. 2, 1850 in La(a)bes, Pommerania, Germany. Died Aug. 23, 1911 in Seneca Twp. Mc Henry Co., Ill.. To U.S.A. 1878-82, relatives in La Crosse, Wisc.. Married A(E)melia Anna Naatz/Nates/Nattz born July 6, 1850-57 Germany. They Married 1876 ? in Germany. She died March 28, 1933 in Marengo. (Pommerania)

Bingenheimer, Michael James born Dec. 10, 1874 in Schleisingerville, now Slinger, Washington Co. Wisconsin. Ran a meat market on state st. in Belvidere. Died Dec. 22, 1953/54 Belvidere, Ill.. Married Theresa Anne Murrin at St. James Catholic church in Belvidere April 11, 1917-18. He is descended from Valentine, from Henry, from John Adam Joseph Bingenheimer who came on ship Irad Ferry from Antwerp to N.Y. arriving July 12, 1843. They lived in the area of Selzen, Schwabsburg, Hess-Darmstadt province which is now in Rheinhessen Co, in Rheinland Pfalz state, So. of Mainz on Rhein river. Henry was in the civil war and his father was drafted by Napoleon I, when Napoleon conquered S/W Germany. A few of these Washington Co., Wisc. Germans moved on to Stephenson Co., Ill.. The Bingenheimers went to Milwaukee & West Bend area of Wisc.. There are now Bingenheimer descendants in Colorado, Wisc., Ill., Minn., Montana, Calif.. Conn, Jane Ellen born Nov. 1852-3 in Ireland or Cobleskill, Schoharie Co., N.Y.. Died May 18, 1901 in Belvidere. Married William Fleming May 12, 1869 ? Brother John Conn-

-lived near harvard, Ill.. Her Father George Conn born May 8, 1824 in Curley, Monaghan Co., Ireland. To U.S.A. 1850 ? Married 1851 ? to Mary Bradley. He died Oct. 1900 Mc Henry Co. and she died May 16, 1902 in Lercy twp., Boone Co., Ill.. She was born Dec. 24, 1830-31 in Ireland or N.Y..

Flemming, William born 1875 ? Garden Prairie, Boone Co. Ill.. Died Oct. 7, 1955 Belvidere. 1st. wife Cora Pease who's parents took his son Frank to California & Portland, Oregon. 3rd. wife was Martha Belle Mc Cachran. A Brother Thomas Fleming stayed in N.Y. state. 2nd wife was Alma Elma Elnora Jeanette Nicks. William's father was William Fleming born Feb. 1837-8 in Coothill, Derrygone, Monahan Co. or Cork Co., Ireland. Died May 1913 Lawrenceville, Boone Co., Ill.. married Jane Ellen Conn. He came to U.S. in 1850 ? to Boone Co. in 1855 ? His father was John Fleming born Oct. 1797 Ireland & died April 25, 1889 in Lawrenceville. married Mary Reyborn/Rahburn/Rahbar/Ryburn 1825. She was born May 1, 1803 in Monahan Co, Ireland. Died Feb. 4, 1891 Lawrenceville Roadfarm. Some people have confussed this line with another Fleming/Flemming line supposedly from Scotland.
