Perhaps an explanation of numbers would be appropriate in the study of this list of men from Boone County, Illinois who gave their lives during the American Civil War (1861 – 1865).

There are 237 men's names on this list. These 237 men thus represent 2% of Boone County's total population at the time of the Civil War. Perhaps of more importance is the fact that they are 17.2% of the 1,372 men that served from the county during the hostilities.

Boone County's population at the time of the Civil War was 11,670 people. Of these, 1,755 were subject to eligibility for duty according to the Adjutant General's Office at the time. Eligibility, at that time, consisted of being male between the ages of 18 and 45. The county accumulated a total of \$30,353.63 in expenditures on bounties for its men. This averaged a grand total of \$22.70 per man.
